Check-In

Arrive at the fields at least 30 minutes early, please sign in, and you will receive a try-out number for evaluations. Prior to your try-out time, please prepare yourself with your equipment.

Evaluation Phase

Evaluators will be grading and taking notes during your entire try-out time slot. This will be done from warm-up's, through skill sets and match play. Besides skill, athleticism and soccer knowledge & experience, attitude and work rate are key factors as well. Always try to be on you mental and physical game at all times.

Recommended Participation

A minimum of two (2) try-outs will be recommended of each player candidate to be evaluated and considered for a possible rostered spot on a Rangers Division 1 or 3 team. The more the better.

Manteca Rangers United offers any team an opportunity to qualify to compete in the State

Premier league. State Premier teams representing Cal-North challenge their elite soccer skills in competitions against other CYSA State Premier teams. The Rangers United players participating in the State Premier league are provided an opportunity to match skills with some of the best in the sport in California.

Division 1 is for those who desire to play at the highest level of competitive soccer. just shy of Premier. The commitment, dedication and training level of all Division 1 players is the same of Premier. Their District league playing season also mirrors the September-December time frame with State cup National Championships shortly after. Teams will play league games every Saturday (or a total of 10-12 games). Teams will also compete in monthly tournaments both in and outside the state. Teams will typically train 2-3 days per week.

Division 3 is an Intermediate Competitive level. The objective is to develop players to prepare them for Division 1 and Premier future opportunities. The average season mirrors Division 1. finishing with Association Cup Championships. Teams train 2-3 days B week and play 1 or 2 games every Saturday similar to Division 1 teams.

The Manteca Rangers United program is devoted towards working to achieve high levels of success by helping our teams and players maximize their development potential in the game of soccer. Bringing the best resources to our members will develop the best player atmosphere, and allow for the most individual success possible within the club.
